

WAIVER OF MATH EDUCATION INTERNSHIP I PETITION FORM

Directions: In order to have Internship I in Math Education waived, you must provide evidence that **documents and describes** the following components at both the elementary and secondary levels. Evidence includes unit plans, lesson plans, assessment plans, or student work. In addition to completion of this form, you must read and follow the directions on the Petition to Waive Internship I.

Please consider a waiver of Internship I as I have met the following requirements (attach specific documentation for each):

- 1. Assisted teacher in a classroom

- 2. Graded papers with particular attention given to:
 - student error patterns
 - opportunities for alternative assessment
 - connecting assessment to student work

- 3. Visited school library (Curriculum Center, Learning Resource Center) with particular attention given to:
 - determining mathematics holdings for students
 - determining mathematics holdings for teacher
 - investigating availability of technology for student use
 - investigating availability of technology for teacher use

- 4. Worked with individual students as requested by teacher

- 5. Worked with small groups of students as requested by teacher

- 6. Created tests that reflect instruction presented by teacher

- 7. Discussed lesson plans created by teacher with attention given to:
 - use of manipulatives
 - varieties of methods of instruction
 - attention to varying modalities
 - infusion of technology
 - plans for assessment of student learning and teacher effectiveness

- 8. Visited other classes as an observer (not necessarily math classes) to:
 - observe different teaching styles
 - gain ideas of how to integrate different content areas into math
 - compare student attitudes and interest
